## Who We Are:

Friends of the Ouachita Trail (FoOT) is a non-profit organization (IRS 501c3) created by trail users to maintain the Ouachita National Recreation Trail or Ouachita Trail (OT) and other trails of the Ouachita Mountains as healthy and enjoyable outdoor recreational assets.



## What We Do:

FoOT is made up primarily of trail users who perform volunteer labor to maintain the Ouachita Trail, Black Fork Mountain Trail, Eagle Rock Loop, and the Womble Trail in the Ouachita Mountains. Our Adopt-a-Trail program is supplemented with certified chain saw operators and organized work parties to keep the trails healthy. FoOT works with the agencies and landowners with jurisdiction over the trails. We actively partner with the US Forest Service, Oklahoma and Arkansas State Parks, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, Central Arkansas Water, and landowners to make sure the trails are available for all hikers, backpackers, hunters, and bikers.
